A CAMP IS PLANNED AT ONE OF THE CAMP GROUNDS FOR THOSE WHO DO NOT WANT TO DRIVE BACK SATURDAY NIGHT. EACH PARTICIPANT MUST HAVE THE FOLLOWING EQUIPMENT:

1. CRAMPONS TO FIT YOUR BOOTS
2. ICE AXE WITH WRIST SLING
3. LEATHER GLOVES
4. FOOD
5. CAMPING GEAR IF YOU'RE GOING TO CAMP
6. 2 EA. 1/4" DIAMETER X 10'-0" LONG MANILA ROPES
7. A CLIMBING ROPE IF YOU HAVE ONE

1. USE OF CRAMPONS
2. USE OF ICE AXE
3. USE OF ROPES AND SLINGS
4. USE OF ICE PITONS
5. RIGGING FOR RESCUE OPERATIONS
